



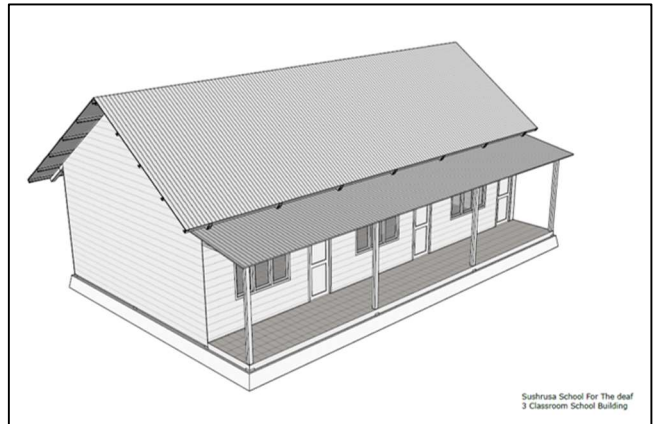

We thank them for supporting our club's North Vancouver Canada Day Celebrations, Community Service initiative.



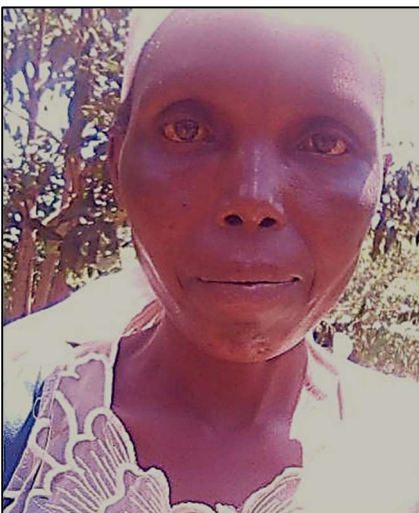

Lions Gate Rotary was instrumental in establishing the Safe House, which first opened in 2002. HCSS took over management in 2008 after a brief closure, and RCLG has remained supportive through funding and hands-on efforts such as repairs and landscaping. We are currently discussing possible future projects.

Treasurer Ron Shaw and President Ian met with the Rotary Club of Vancouver Cambie President, Q Doh Pae to discuss our club's involvement with the **Santa Photo Day** for pets fundraising event.
